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PREFACE

The Bible claims “*the word*” is “*The Word Of God.*” Jesus is, also, called “*The Word of God.*” How can this be? There seems to be a contradiction. What do *the scriptures* teach?

This book is entirely *free* and no money is accepted. Your job is to pray and study to show yourself approved. If God has blessed you, Jesus said to help the orphans, widows and the poor. If you have any questions, comments or any criticisms please send them and we will try to give you *the scriptures* that will solidify the point. Add any *scriptures* we may have overlooked.

Art is now on his 80th book. Through the years we have tried to fine tune the books. Our attempt is to make them easier to read. Then Art had the idea to put “like books” which dovetail into each other. So, when you are interested in a certain subject he has combined those books in Volumes. As time goes by new books may be added to a block of books in any of the volumes. He has also added a Master title for each of the volumes. Always read a book then start over checking all *the scriptures* making sure you are reading what God wants you to understand – straight from his “Word” – *The Bible*.

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INTRODUCTION

The Greek word “*logos*” means “*the word*” in English. By definition it suggests “*thought and logic*,” which is “*intellectual reasoning*.” Whose intellect is this and how can two beings, God and Jesus, claim to be “*the word*?”

Some Christians claim it is *a great mystery*. “*Mystery*” merely means “*one does not know*.” Even *The Bible* claims *The Mystery of God* is “*Christ – In You*,” which is *the hope of glory* (Colossians 1:27).

Knowing this *mystery*, all Christians and Jews can have the hope and faith of receiving God’s *glory*. In Greek the word for “*glory*” is “*doxa*.” *The Old Testament* clearly defines God’s *glory* as “*all of God’s goodness*.”

Jesus tells you only God is *good* (perfection), “*And he said to him, Why call you me good? There is none good but one, that is, God*” (Matthew 19:17). “*And he said, I beseech you, show me your glory* [Moses requested of God]. *And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before you and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy*” (Exodus 33:18-19).

Since no one has seen God or heard His voice, this was God’s messenger (an angel) taking the authority of God’s name and speaking as an ambassador for God (Acts 7:30-33, 38).

God’s *glory* and *goodness* passed before Moses. This glory is passed on a King when he sits on his throne to

make judgments. Servants, by his side, proclaim the king's greatness.

Since only God is *good* and *perfect*, how can Jesus be God's *word*, as *The Bible's* mystery reveals? As astounding as it may seem, this mystery is only revealed to God's people, who are *the saints* and *the faithful* (Ephesians 1:1-9).

Now, you are confronted with another dilemma. The Word of The One True God is perfect. How can Jesus be The Word of God? God's saints understand this great mystery of "*Christ – In You.*"

CHRIST – IN YOU

The Biblical answer is wonderful and reveals God's great love for humanity and all His creation. The Apostle Paul writes how the entire creation waits for this mystery to be made known, "*For the creature* [God's creation] *was made subject to vanity* [no purpose], *not willingly, but by reason* [intellect] *of him* [God] *who has subjected the same in hope*" (Romans 8:20). God, purposely, made His creation unable to find *any purpose* in living this human existence, "*For we know that the whole creation* [world] *groans* [seeking purpose to existence] *and travails in pain together until now* [Christ's mystery]. *And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits* [spiritual growth] *of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan* [in pain and stress] *within ourselves, waiting for the adoption* [Sons of God], *to wit, the redemption* [God's glory] *of our body* [human]" (Romans 8:22-23).

How simple! The world, finds little purpose in this

human existence. Rather, they are often in pain or full of sorrow. The Christians, Jews and Muslims wait for their Messiah so they can be saved and find *purpose in life* (Romans 8:21-23).

The saints and faithful search the scriptures to solve this Mystery of “Christ – In You.” You are about to find the answer to this baffling mystery. The conclusion will manifest God’s wonderful purpose for human existence.

Jesus, The Christ, is God’s Apostle, filled with God’s Holy Spirit (a gift) without measure. God granted Jesus *all the things* He created.

God’s Mystery is “*Christ – In You,*” the hope of glory (Colossians 1:27). You, now, know the process of how you, as Christ’s *bride-to-be*, become His *wife* receiving The Glory of God with His *righteousness* (Revelation 19:7-8). The Mystery of Christ is summarized in Hebrews 1:1-4. Christ, as your High Priest, Melchizedek, not only inherited all things but with God’s power made all things.

CHAPTER 1

WHOSE WORD?

The world claims *a trinity*. From the beginning, in The Garden of Eden, Adam, Eve and Satan (a snake) were the world's first *trinity*. (Read the book, *Satan's Image*). From Christ's birth, the world's *trinity* is God, Jesus and The Holy Spirit. Who is right? Is there *a trinity*? The answer, scripturally, is in knowing *who* and *what* is God's *word*.

THE WILDERNESS TEST

When Jesus was in the wilderness and did not eat for forty days and nights, Satan confronted Him and said, "*If you be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread*" (Matthew 4:3).

Satan knew The Son of God would come but did not know Jesus was that Son. The angels did not know who The Messiah would be, either (I Peter 1:12).

Satan formerly was *a cherub*, a high angel, who became the devil (Ezekiel 28:14). Satan asked Jesus to prove He was God's Son, The Messiah. Since Jesus was hungry, Satan said, "*Command the stones to be bread.*" Christ replied, "*Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God*" (Matthew 4:4). Je-

Jesus Christ said "*the word*," – "*the logos*," were God's very *words* and not His. How could Jesus be *The Word* of God? Jesus never said *the word* was His *personal word*. Well, how does this all come to be?

This *word*, which was God, was in the beginning and made (created) all things (John 1:1-3). Then, John writes an amazing verse, "*This is the work of God, that you believe on him whom he has sent*" (John 6:29). This claim or idea seems very mysterious. Jesus describes three points:

- 1) God did *the work* in the past, in the present and will do *the work* in the future, but Jesus does not.
- 2) You are to believe in Christ as God's Son.
- 3) God, The Father, sent Him. Christ plainly said of Himself, "*The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he sees the Father do: For what things soever he does, these also does the Son likewise*" (John 5:19). Christ was The Apostle of God, His Son (Hebrews 3:1).

Jesus was sent by God and did what was asked of Him. God, The Father is actually doing The Work since Christ, being a human, can do nothing by Himself (John 5:19). But what work did Jesus do? The Savior said He was *the bread of life*. He miraculously provided 5,000 meals. Now, He uses this physical example as a metaphor. He is *the bread* which gives *Salvation*.

In the wilderness Satan tells Jesus He has the power to make food from the stones. Christ's reply was, "*Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God*" (Matthew 4:4). Now, it makes sense. It is God's word from The Father's mouth by which Jesus, *the man, lived*. God was doing *the work* within Christ.

The works that your Messiah did were actually God working "In Christ," "And now come I to you; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves. I [The Messiah] have given them [disciples] your word [not Christ's]; and the world has hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world" (John 17:13-14).

"*Christ – In You*" (Colossians 1:27) is actually God, The Father doing His work "*In You*" (Genesis 1:1). God, Himself, did the work. Remember, Jesus, the human, could do nothing. Jesus said, "*For the Son of man is come to save [restore] that which was lost*" (Matthew 18:11). What was *lost*? God's very word, The Tree of Life, was lost.

GOD'S PUZZLE

The Mystery of God is *a puzzle*. (The book *God's Puzzle Solved* give insight to the reader after this amazing puzzle). It is *a puzzle* filled with innumerable pieces and has *no ending*. It is *eternal*. The study of *doctrine*, which is just "*a part*," is *an unending process* (I Corinthians:13:12). Paul warned individuals that they are liable to be "*tossed to and fro*" when studying *doc-*

trines (Ephesians 4:14). **Jesus accomplished every word God taught Him. This is the reason you are to reach the full maturity of Christ (Ephesians 4:13). Christ did The Work of God.**

MOSES' PROPHECY

The Pharisees constantly wanted proof that Jesus was The Messiah. Here is what Jesus told them, “Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuses you, even Moses, in whom you trust. For had you believed Moses, you would have believed me: for he wrote of me. But if you believe not his writings, how shall you believe my words?” (John 5:45-47). Where did Moses prophecy about Christ and how can you tell a true Prophet from a false one? “The LORD your God will raise up to you a Prophet from the midst of you, of your brethren [Israel], like to me [God]; to him you shall hearken” (Deuteronomy 18:15).

This Prophet is like God, but is a human. What made this Prophet just like God? “I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like to you and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak to them [Israel] all that I shall command him” (Deuteronomy 18:18).

Scripture must interpret scripture. Isaiah 28 writes, “Whom shall he [God] teach knowledge?” One must be teachable like a babe and be taught “here a little and there a little” – it is a growing process.

How do you tell truth from fiction? “The testimony

of Jesus is the spirit [witness] of prophecy” (Revelation 19:10). Here is the proof of who The Messiah is, “*When a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD [authority], if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken, but the prophet has spoken it presumptuously [by guessing]: you shall not be afraid of him*” (Deuteronomy 18:22).

Quite simple! Jesus was not *the word* in the beginning; it was God, Himself. God always *does* the work. Jesus tells you that The Word of God was put “*In Him*” and The Word did *the work*. God is The Only One who is *good*. God’s *glory* works “*In Christ*” and does His work for Him.

How can this be? Since God is “*In Christ*,” who is The Son of Man? The Muslims are right – Jesus is The Prophet of God. How did Jesus create all things since it was God, The Father, who made all things (Hebrews 3:4)? Now, you will learn how Jesus created all things.

CHAPTER 2

CHRIST'S INHERITANCE

Jesus was The Son of Man and was from the line of King David. He was *The Word* of God. How could this be? A miracle (a great power) transpired at His birth that had never before happened.

FIRST-BORN SON

Before Jesus, an angel came and told Mary how this *birth* would be different, “*And the angel answered and said to her, the Holy Ghost [Spirit] shall come upon you [God sent] and the power of the Highest [Elohim] shall overshadow [cover] you: therefore also that holy thing [Holy Spirit] which shall be born of you shall be called the Son of God*” (Luke 1:35).

“*The word*” in Jesus was of God (John 1:1-3). The Holy Spirit, created Jesus making Him Holy. Christ was *sent* in the flesh, from God, and was given *The Word of God*.

God has *no darkness* in Him. He is “*light*” and it was very *good* (John 1:5). John states that *The Birth* of Christ occurred because of The Will of God (John 1:13). The Holy Spirit makes Jesus and those who receive The Holy Spirit Sons of God. The Birth of Jesus was not *an adoption*, as with everyone else, “*And the*

word [God's] *was made flesh* [human] *and dwelt among us* [humans]" – so simple to understand (John 1:14). God sent His Holy Spirit (which was The Word of God) from *heaven to dwell* in Jesus, since He was born. Jesus, The Son of Man, was all human, but by receiving God's Holy Spirit, became The Word of God. Jesus was not God until He was *glorified*. When you are *adopted*, the same Holy process transpires with you.

GOD BUILDS ALL THINGS

The Book of Hebrews explains the responsibility of Moses, Jesus and God (Hebrews 3:1-4). Christ is *The One* sent from God, as *an Apostle*, in addition to being *The High Priest* (Melchizedek) (Hebrews 3:1).

Moses was sent to faithfully *build* his house as *a testimony* (a witness). Moses *witnessed* The Christ to come. Jesus was *faithful* and gave more than *a witness* by building God's house. Moses' testimony (*The Law*) was God's method to lead them "*To Christ*" (Galatians 3:24).

Jesus, as The Word of God, built His house as *a Spiritual Temple* (The Church) (I Corinthians 3:16). It is not a physical temple. That *spiritual temple* was *built* by God's Holy Spirit, just like Christ. The Holy Spirit is God *doing the work*, "*This is the work of God, that you believe on him whom he has sent*" (John 6:29). It is important that you now consider the difference between God's Holy Spirit and The Christ.

To help you understand more clearly read John 3:31-

35 thoroughly, “*Sanctify* [seal] *them* [Holy Spirit] *through your truth: your word is truth*” (John 17:17).

Now, to put this all together: **The Work of God is done by God alone, through His Holy Spirit.**

- 1) The Holy Spirit only comes through God. What comes from *the earth* is *earthly* (human).
- 2) What The Holy Spirit sees is *testified* through Christ, *the human*. The Word of God through God’s Holy Spirit “*will seal*” all converted Christians.
- 3) Only Jesus received *all* of God’s Holy Power and His Holy Spirit from *birth* without *measure* (complete).
- 4) Because God *loves* His Son, He has *put all things* into His hands.

You have just *scripturally* read *the whole account* of how Jesus, *The Groom*, prepares the way for you to be His wife and calls it *a mystery* (Ephesians 5:25-35). This introduction describes how that *inheritance will come to pass*.

The Torah, The First Five Books of *The Bible*, is *The Way* or *The Path*. In what direction does *the way* or *path* lead? *The Law of Moses* was to lead you “*To Christ*” (Galatians 3:21). Christ said to Martha, “*I am the resurrection and the life: he that believes in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live*” (John 11:25).

Jesus, who *inherited all things*, is *the path* or way to *life eternal in Paradise*. Christ with His *inheritance* speaks only *The Word of God* (*The Path to Life* and by *eating of The Tree of Life*). There is no greater plan.

Jesus came to give *grace* and *truth* (John 1:17). Moses gave *The Law* to Israel regarding *The Promised Land*. This was the land guaranteed to Abraham. This *Law* did not require *repentance*, because only *Jesus could give grace* (faith). *The Law of Moses* was given for *unrepentant sinners* who *feared God*, but had a *wrong heart* (Hebrews 3:10 and I Timothy 1:7-10). By nature, they were still *unrighteous sinners*. So, they gave them a path (step by step) to lead them to repent.

Messianic Jews and Christians are only required to *fear God* and desire His *righteousness* (Acts 10:34-35). *The Torah*, with the *added Law* in Deuteronomy, covers *the story of the whole world*.

Paul said, “*I am debtor both to the Greeks and to the Barbarians: both to the wise and to the unwise*” (Romans 1:14-16). Christ is *The Author* (written word) (Hebrews 12:2) and *The Way and Path* to *The Abrahamic Promises*. The first promise was *The Land of Canaan*. Then, with Isaac's *sacrifice* came *the promised seed* who would *bless the whole world*. Christ came to *Save The World* (I John 4:14).

Jesus *inherited all things* that are His to give in *The White Throne Judgment*, but there is a *time limit* to His *inheritance*, “*Then comes the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father;*

when he shall have put down [footstool] all rule and all authority and power” (I Corinthians 15:24).

As King of Kings during *The Millennium*, He gives back *all His inheritance* to His Father. When is this? “*For the Father judges no man, but has [inherited] committed all judgment to the Son” (John 5:22).* Does it not seem odd that God takes back *the inheritance* He gave to Christ? Note that this return occurs after *The White Throne Judgment*. Why? Animal sacrifices can never remove sin (Hebrews 10:1-3). The sacrifices were meant to remind the people that they were *still sinners*, when they came to sacrifice year by year.

A body prepared by God through His Holy Spirit was needed to give *grace* (mercy). *The Law was a shadow and a picture* (puzzle) of heavenly things (Hebrews 8:1-5). Jesus’ *sacrifice* was more *excellent* because it *destroyed sin* and changed a person’s *heart and mind*. *The Law is spiritually kept through God’s Holy Spirit* (Hebrew 8:6-13). *The Old Covenant* ceased with the destruction of The Temple in 70 A.D. *The Book of Hebrews* was the transition, since The Temple was still standing (Hebrews 8:4).

Jesus passed His *inheritance* on to His Wife, His *Bride*. This inheritance was passed on as Christ’s body and *the denominations* received their *lot or partial inheritance*, “*For he said to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion” (Romans 9:15).* The One giving *mercy* is God (Romans 9:16). Jesus had God’s Holy Spirit, which is The Word of God, through *inheri-*

tance. God does *the judging* through His Son who received "*the inheritance,*" that came from God. *Every High Priest* can have *compassion on sinners* (Hebrews 5:1-2). Why? *Every High Priest of men,* which includes *Christ,* has *compassion* because they, too, lived in *the flesh.*

Enough words cannot be found to tell you how wonderful God truly is! What is so wonderful for you to know is by His Holy Spirit, He will make you *perfect.* Through *inheritance,* Jesus is The Messiah. He has compassion and gives *grace* and *mercy,* because He knows human weaknesses. How great is God's *word?* God's Holy Spirit, through *The Messiah,* can judge *righteously.* Christ, being human, understands fully what Christians *experience in their fleshly life!*

CHAPTER 3

GOD ALL-IN-ALL

Jesus will destroy God's *last enemy*, which is death. Death will be destroyed at *The White Throne Judgment*. Before He returns The Kingdom to God, *death* must be eliminated (I Corinthians 15:53-56).

WHAT DESTROYS SIN?

Only when every *jot* and *tittle* of *The Law* is fulfilled (perfected) can sin be done away (Matthew 5:17-18). Notice, not only *The Law*, but all that *The Prophets* said about Him had to be fulfilled (Matthew 5:48). Wow! Every Word of God, God's school and prophecy must be fulfilled and completed. (The book, *God's School* narrates these details of this important fulfillment).

GOD'S TEACHING METHOD

The Apostle Paul was well-informed by God's Holy Spirit and *the truth* which was The Word of God. Jesus was not God's *word*, but was filled with God's *word* at His birth by *the overshadowing* of God's Holy Spirit, "*For we know in part and we prophesy* [God's word] *in part*" (I Corinthians 13:9).

When you repent and want a change of your heart and mind (Babylon), you start as a "*little babe*." Paul writes

the process, “*When I was a child [babe], I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child [dependent]: but when I became a man, I put away childish things. For now we see through a glass [mirror-eyes], darkly [partly]; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known*” (I Corinthians 13:11-12). When is this? “*But when that which is perfect [God’s glory – goodness] is come, then that which is in part [Babylon] shall be done away*” (I Corinthians 13:10).

There it is – *the whole truth* and process completely explains why you have been born as a human to become a Son of God; it is *evolutionary*.

GOD'S HOLY SPIRIT

Before Christ was crucified, He told His Disciples (students) how He would continue *teaching* them, “*Howbeit when he [God’s], the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth [perfection]: for he [God’s] shall not speak of himself [the teacher]; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak [God’s word] and he will show you things to come*” (John 16:13).

How clear! Christ tells His Disciples this Holy Spirit *glorifies* Him since He became “*the word*” by The Holy Spirit (John 16:14). Again, Paul teaches you what you really need to learn, “*Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus*” (Philippians 2:5). His *mind* is of *The Holy Spirit*.

The Apostle Paul reveals this mind to Timothy, a

young Evangelist, “*For God has not given us the spirit of fear; but of power and of love [agapé] and of a sound mind*” (II Timothy 1:7).

It can not be any plainer than *The Bible* tells you. God’s *word* is God’s *very mind* and *thoughts*. He explains how He *thinks*. God’s *sound mind* has *power* and *love* for His creation. Therefore, God is “*the logos*.” He is completely and perfectly *logical*. Wow! The Holy Spirit is God’s *very mind, power* and *love*.

The Holy Spirit is The Word of God (Matthew 4:4) and it is perfection and excellence! Jesus informed Satan when he knows only part of *the truth* (doctrine) it is not the same as knowing *the entire truth*. Satan knew God’s *scriptures* but only “*in part*,” as most Christians do.

Satan, as Christ said, was *a liar* from the beginning (John 8:44). He is *The Father of Lies*. Satan is *the author* of *Babylon*. He misuses *doctrine* by being *dogmatic* and forces his *mind* on others. However, Satan dispenses only limited truth. Everyone is in *Babylon* and “*only knows in part*” like Satan.

Job had the same problem as Christians. His problem was that, when he repented in sackcloth and ashes, he told God he had thought much too much of himself. God’s *knowledge* is far superior to that of any human. Job finally got *the point* (Job 40:1-6).

Why did The Letter of *The Law* depict *repentance* with *sackcloth* and *ashes*? Remember, *The Law* is only

a shadow, like *human nature*, which only knows “*in part*” (Hebrews 10:1).

Sackcloth is what a person wears. Ashes is all that is left when a person dies. “*Baptism*” is “*the death of your ways of thinking*” (the human mind). Sackcloth is *a shadow* of what humans are *made* from. Ashes or *dust* are all that remain of every human when death comes to them.

Repentance is your *Baptism* to allow *your mind to die*. Repentance allows His *truth*, by The Holy Spirit, to change your *mind* and *way of thinking* (spiritually).

JOB'S MIND IS HUMAN

The Book of Job was not written for Atheists and Agnostics, but rather, for Christians and Messianic Jews. Job was *perfect in all his ways*. He lived a good life but was still human. He needed to repent as you need to do. As a Christian, you must always pray and keep God close to you.

Those of you on *The Pathway to Life* who *seek* God's *righteousness* must be *super-cautious*. *Perfection is the goal*. Until you are *complete*, like God, you are *still in Babylon*. That is why Jesus told His *people* to come out of Babylon (Revelations 18:4).

God's aim is to be *All In All*. Perfection of humanity is God's *will* and *pre-planned purpose*. With *free choice* and having absolute *faith* in God, you need to *grow spiritually* through His Holy Spirit. *The Holy Spirit is*

God's word, mind and all that God is (Elohim).

Jesus, a human Son of Man, had *a human nature*. He could have failed *without faith and free choice*. But, Jesus was *faithful* (Revelation 1:5). He as *The Author* or showing the *way to truth* is The Word of God.

When Christ prayed to His Father, He prayed not to go through the crucifixion. But He wanted The Father's *will* to prevail. Jesus was as human as you. Having God's Holy Spirit in full measure from birth, He knew every Word of God. God sent His Holy Spirit to Jesus. This same Holy Spirit will help you on your way to Salvation.

CHAPTER 4

GOD'S WILL FULFILLED

Isaiah prophesied about God's *will* and *desired purpose*. The name "*Isaiah*" means "*God saves*." Isaiah covers all of the prophecies about the corruption of God's children. Both Israel and Judah went into captivity and were scattered throughout all nations as corn is sifted through a sieve (Amos 9:9). Isaiah concludes with Israel and Judah back in Jerusalem at the world's new headquarters of The Kingdom of God.

Christ's *Millennial "rule"* with His Bride follows and announces The Wedding Feast. It is God's purpose, through Christ, to Save The World (I John 4:14).

CHRIST THE AUTHOR

The first person to fulfill *all of God's word* is *The Author of Salvation*. An author writes a book, *word by word*, to its conclusion. Every Word of Christ must lead you to *Salvation in Paradise – The Kingdom of God*. The Word of God is The Father's *words* given to Jesus at His birth by The Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit was *the source* of The Word of God. Christ received God's *word* (an inheritance) in complete measure as God's First-Born Son (John 3). A family is to follow.

THE GIFTS

“Howbeit, when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth [like Christ]: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come [prophecy]. He shall glorify [goodness] me: for he shall receive of mine [inheritance] and shall show it to you. All things that the Father has are mine, therefore said I, that he shall take of mine and shall show it to you” (John 16:13-15).

Jesus was not The Word of God when He was born. Beyond doubt He *inherited* everything from God. The Holy Spirit is God's *power* (Elohim) and *love* (all caring) from *a sound mind* (II Timothy 1:7). God's Holy Spirit is God, The Father, Himself. The Father always does *the work* just as when He created the heaven and earth in The Beginning (Hebrews 3:4).

Neither Jesus, God's Son, nor any other part of His Creation can build all things, only God, The Father, can, as *The Bible* clearly dictates. All the creatures God made, including The Messiah, are vane and useless (without God). God always does *the work*. By *inheritance*, Jesus *owns* all things that God has given Him. Now Christ, as The Word of God, has *the same gift* from God. God's Holy Spirit is God, *The Father's very word!*

GOD BECOMES ALL-IN-ALL

Christ will *inherit all things* when He conquers *death*

(I Corinthians 15). **The Savior cannot turn over The Kingdom to God until Christ conquers death.**

Why does Jesus have to conquer *death* before God can accept The Kingdom?

God, being all *goodness*, will not *dwell with sin* (Isaiah 59). Sin must be destroyed. Sin, transgressing God's Law, is the cause of death. By *The Law* death reigns (I Corinthians 15:53-57). When you are "*In Christ*," *The Law* is *fulfilled* or *completed* (Matthew 5:18). You are no longer under *The Law*, but are "*In Christ*." God's *Law* is now *written* in your *heart* (desires) and *mind* (thoughts).

Christ told you prophecy would be *revealed to you* through God's Holy Spirit (John 16:13). All prophecy and *The Law* must be completed and come to *perfection*. God will only *dwell with man*, when everyone comes to Christ. Every man will come "*To Christ*" in his own *order* (I Corinthians 15:23).

THE IMAGE OF GOD

From *the beginning* (The Alpha) God's pre-planned purpose was to make man in God's *image* just like Jesus, *The First-born* of God (Hebrews 1:3). To be like God and in His image, you must have His *power, love* and *sound mind* (only truth).

- 1) In Philippians 2, Paul writes God's *mind* is *superior* to any other *mind*. He has the Highest I.Q. (Isaiah 55:7-11).

- 2) God is *love* and, unless you have the love of God "*In You*," you do *not know God*. To be in God's *image*, you must, also, possess *the love of God* (I John 4:8).

- 3) God's *power* is the other *element* of God's *image*. Elohim, The Father, possesses *all power* and is *The Almighty One*. You, likewise, in order to be in His *image*, will have that *power to create* whatever God's Holy Spirit *guides* you to create in the future.

Do you grasp how wonderful and good God is? You are to become like God and Jesus. You can and will become like your Brother and your Father, "*And for their [disciples] sakes I sanctify [seal] myself, that they also might be sanctified [sealed] through the truth [God's Holy Spirit]. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word. That they all may be one [image]; as you, Father, are in me [Holy Spirit] and I in you, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that you have sent me [Holy Spirit]. And the glory [goodness] which you gave me [inherit] I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them and you in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that you have sent me and has loved them, as you have loved me*" (John 17:19-23). "*Two can only walk together when they be in agreement*" (Amos 3:3).

The goal is to be exactly alike, so eventually great accomplishments can be made without bickering and always in agreement. It will be kind after kind. The

family of God will comprise all The Sons of God. Then God will be “*All-In-All.*”

You should look forward to when God will *dwell with man in The Kingdom of God – a new beginning.* Under *The New Heavens* and on *The New Earth* God will *make all things new.* *The beginning* will become *the end,* which continues as *a new beginning.* Then, Eternity will reign in Paradise – “the beginning” becomes “the end.” This is another mystery that will be explained.

Under *The New Heavens* and on *The New Earth* God once again *rests with man in a Jubilee* (Sabbath of Rest). God will have finished doing *the work,* as He had done in “*the beginning.*”

Any *doctrine* which does not lead you to be in God's *image* is *false.* Do not be swayed when churches bicker about doctrines. Doctrinal truth is only *fulfilled* when it leads you to be in *the exact image* of God. Only then can you be in The Family of God. Follow God's step, so you can be on the path to join your brother Jesus and your Heavenly Father.
